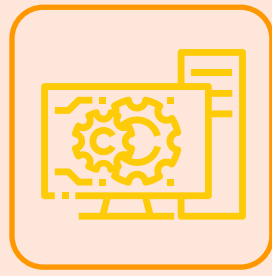

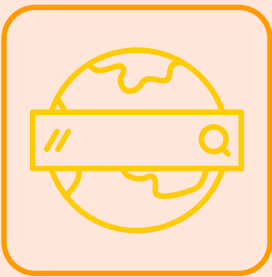

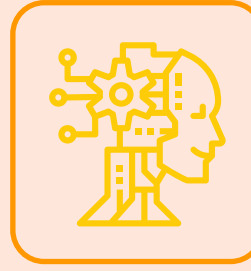

# Class Saathi Success Story

Every month, we honor a tale of triumph from Indian classrooms. This month we recognize Dashrath Kumar Maurya, an assistant instructor at Composite School, Gobrahan, Uttar Pradesh. He has been instrumental in improving access to education for students and has faith that Class Saathi can significantly diminish educational inequality.



**Q.** Thank you for joining us today sir. Could you please introduce yourself?

**Shubhangi**, Team Class Saathi

**A.** Namaste, I am Dashrath Kumar Maurya. I am appointed as an assistant teacher at Composite School, Gobrahan and I teach Math to grades 6,7,8.

**Q.** When did the Class Saathi program begin in your school?

**Shubhangi**, Team Class Saathi

**A.** It's been about 6 months since the program started.

**Q.** Tell us how short class assessments were conducted before the Class Saathi program begin?

**Shubhangi**, Team Class Saathi

**A.** They were pretty orthodox in their nature. The assessments were paper-based, teachers would usually dictate questions, and students pen and paper to write their answers

**Q.** On average how much time did it take you to implement a full assessment cycle? (From creation to correction)

**Shubhangi**, Team Class Saathi

**A.** It'd usually take 75-90 mins to create an assessment of varying difficulty levels. Then another 75-90 mins for the students to attempt the assessment and 45-60 mins of correction time. So all in all 3-4 hours for each assessment.

**Q.** Now that you've been using Class Saathi for some time, how long does it take you to implement a full assessment cycle with Class Saathi?

**Shubhangi**, Team Class Saathi

**A.** As Class Saathi already has varying leveled assessment questions, I just have to select a topic and a sub-topic, and in less than 5 minutes the assessment is ready. Then I present these questions in the class to receive instant student responses through Class Saathi clickers. Again, for correction, I don't have to spend any extra time as the student responses are analyzed in real-time.

**Q.** Is there any transformation you have observed in your classroom with respect to assessments?

**Shubhangi**, Team Class Saathi

**A.** A huge benefit is that I save time. Students respond to the questions using A, B, C, D, or 1, 2, 3, or 4 options on the clicker. Their response time to these questions has decreased. Once they answer a question, the right answer is instantly revealed. It also helps to see who gave the correct answer and who answered the question incorrectly. As a result, it allows me to pay more attention to the student's learning needs. Now I know which students require my attention the most, who is doing well, and who is excelling. I know all of this from Class Saathi.

**Q.** During this time, have you noticed any difference in students?

**Shubhangi**, Team Class Saathi

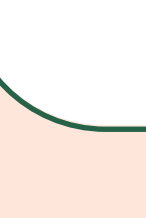
**A.** Students have started responding on time and they aren't as shy, to answer, as they were earlier. Also, the quiz includes a feature that tells me who hasn't answered the questions. I can see the student list of those who have not answered. So I can call out the students and push them to submit their answers. This is not possible with books and pens because you cannot assess whether the student has answered the questions or not till they have submitted their answer sheet. There has been an improvement in attendance as well. Almost 20-30% more students have started actively participating in class now. It has been very good!



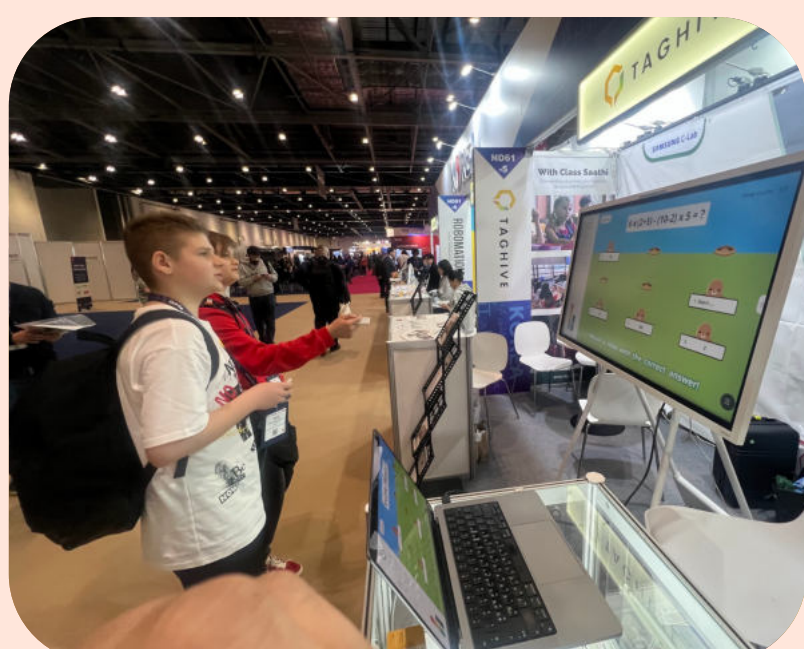
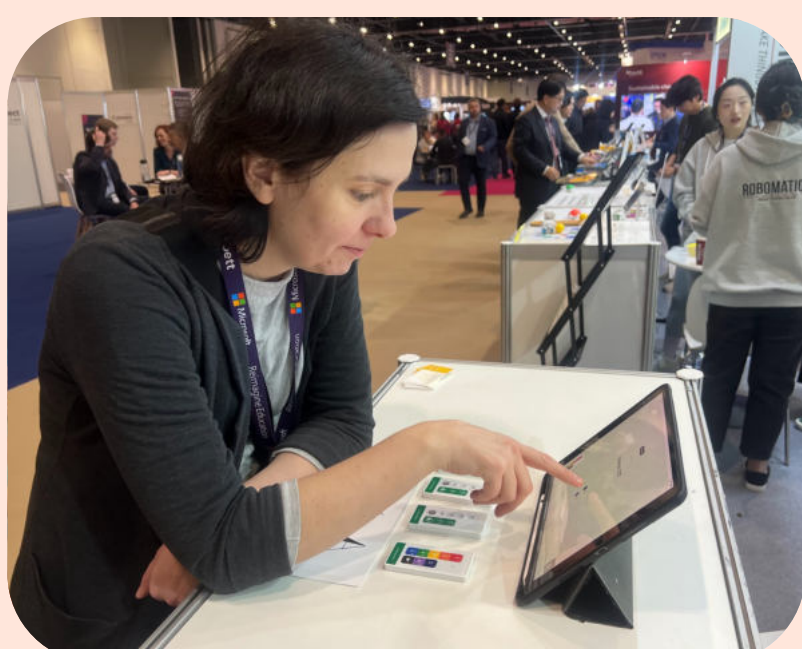
